Together with the 7 x 7mm longitudinal bar gratings made from stainless steel, the channels ensure a barrier-free transition between the offices and the outdoor area.

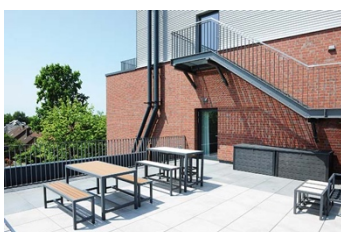
