Product description

The weather vanes are made entirely from high-quality and durable stainless steel. Depending on the size, the flag and motive are cut from stainless steel sheets that are up to 2 mm thick. All joints are welded and screwed, which contribute to maximum stability. Two encapsulated ball bearings on all weather vanes guarantee consistent and smooth rotation, even in the slightest breeze.

In addition to special designs such as guild signs, club signs, favourite animals etc., we also have existing motives to choose from.

Dimensions

The weather vanes are made entirely from stainless steel to customer specifications.

The product is delivered ready for installation. No customisation work is required.

Materials used

Weather vane: Stainless steel sheet (V2A), up to 2 mm thick

Nuts/washers: Stainless steel (V2A)

Processing and care instructions

Care should always be taken when processing weather vanes.

Dust particles of other metals or general cutting of components with flying sparks on the product should be avoided, as they are very sensitive. If dust particles or soiling from other metals are present, these must be removed immediately using appropriate cleaning agents.

In order to maintain the external appearance of the weather vanes in the long term, regular cleaning work is generally recommended. For this purpose, the products should be cleaned by hand using suitable, non-abrasive cleaning agents. See also 'Notes on the use of stainless steel products'.
